National Play-Doh Day! September 16th

Did you know... Play-Doh evolved from a modeling compound that was originally used as wallpaper cleaner invented in the 1930's? Teachers soon discovered it could be used easily for modeling projects and by 1956, it had officially become Play-Doh! After debuting on the children's show Captain Kangaroo, it became an official hit. In 1998, it was inducted into The Strong's National Toy Hall of Fame.

EASY AT HOME RECIPE:

2 cups flour 1 cup salt 4tsp cream of tartar 4 tablespoons oil 2 cups cold water Coloring ingredients (food coloring/turmeric/etc...) Scented ingredients (cinnamon/vanilla extract/lemon juice/essential oil/etc...)

DIRECTIONS:

 Mix dry ingredients add wet ingredients well.
Cook over medium-low heat, stirring continuously, until the dough holds together and is slightly more clear in color.

3. Knead a few times, then let it cool.

GLUTEN-FREE PLAYDOUGH RECIPE:

- ½ cup rice flour
 - 2 tsp cream of tartar
- ½ cup salt
- 1/2 cup cornstarch
- p salt ½ C
- 1 tsp cooking oil 1 cup water (colored if desired)
- 1. Mix cornstarch and water.
- 2. Mix all other dry ingredients.
- 3. Add oil to wet ingredients.
- 4. Mix together well and cook over low heat stirring for about 3 minutes until if forms a ball.
- 5. Knead and let cool.
