### STAFF ANNIVERSARIES





### **FUN FACTS ABOUT FOUNTAIN DAY:**

- We have 7 team members that have been with us for over 15 years, and 3 that have been with us for over 10 years!
- We have a pet tortoise named Charlie who is about 22 years old.
- FDS first opened in 1957 as a preschool, transitioned to elementary and preschool from the early 1980's up until around 12 years ago when it became exclusively preschool aged children once again.
- Over the years, we've had several parents who came here when they were children, who have enrolled their own children here!
- About 6 years ago, the fountain in the courtyard was installed. In the middle is a duck head that was a part of decades old playground toy that used to be on the playground.
- We have the very first Peace Pole in our courtyard! Shortly after it was planted, it was filled
  with notes from those here at FDS of their wishes. There are estimated over 250,000
  Peace Poles in every country in the world dedicated as monuments to peace. Each one
  reads "May Peace Prevail On Earth."
